

Patrons may download files from the Internet to diskettes purchased from the Haven Public Library. Arrangements may be made to leave the disk at the library. If a patron's personal diskettes are used, a virus scan must be run at the beginning of each session.

Personal Internet services, such as E-Mail and listservs, are available by way of an email internet service on the World Wide Web like "Hotmail" or "Yahoo". Patrons may establish their own account and password and use personal Internet services through it. Patrons may not use the library's email account or address for their own use.

Chat rooms and newsgroup access are not available to library patrons. Please do not attempt to use these services on the library's computer.

Printouts will be charged to the patron at 10 cents per page/copy.

Refusal to cooperate with staff in complying with any or all of the above guidelines will result in loss of computer privileges. Illegal acts using information from library resources are subject to prosecution by local, state, or federal officials.
